

ACTIVITIES THAT ACCRUE POINTS:

Activity Type	Point Allocation	Details
Seminar Attendance	One point per seminar hour.	Any seminar that enhances the member's body of knowledge related to naturopathic practice.
Journal Subscriptions	Maximum of 12 points per year per subscription.	Any journal providing relevant knowledge for running of a naturopathic practice/clinic.
Journal Article Submissions	Up to 10 points per article.	Any research-based article written related to naturopathic practice.
ANPA Chapter Attendance	1 point for every hour of an educational activity.	For Chapter meetings around the country go to: www.anpa.asn.au/join-here/anpa-chapters
Book Purchase	1 point per book. Maximum of 6 points per year.	Must be relevant to naturopathy practice. Proof of purchase must be supplied.
Mentoring	1 point per 4 hours. Maximum of 6 points per year.	The date, time, and the name of the mentoree must be noted on the CPE card.
Volunteering	½ point per hour of time. Maximum of 6 points per year.	Dates and tasks to be noted in the CPE record. Contact the ANPA office. There are a variety of tasks available.
ANPA Website Discussion Board Posts	2 points = 6 posts across the year.	Dates of all posts are to be recorded. Only original new posts are valid. If you do not have a password to access the ANPA website discussion board please contact the office at admin@anpa.asn.au
Teaching	One hour of lecturing = 1/2 point. Maximum of 10 points.	Teaching of a naturopathic or health related subject in an approved institution.* Proof of appointment is required. *An approved institution is any school whose graduates are approved as members of ANPA.
Committee Meeting Attendance	One point accrued for each meeting attended.	Contact the ANPA office if you want to join the ANPA Committee.
Post-Graduate Studies	15 points/year	Post-graduate studies related to Naturopathy. Proof of studies required.
*Non-Naturopathic Activities	Maximum of 5 points per membership year	Non-naturopathic activities may include business development, yoga etc. If you are not sure, please contact the office for prior approval.
